

SGCC – LOCAL RULES (R&A Rule 33-8)

To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf of 'R&A Rules Limited'.

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)**
A ball is out of bounds if all of it lies:
 - a) beyond the perimeter fence.
 - b) on or beyond the white line behind the putting green of Hole 2 and Hole 18, and to the left of Green 9.
 - c) on or beyond the white stakes to the left of Hole 3, Hole 14 and Hole 18.
 - d) on or beyond the white stakes to the left of Hole 10 only when playing that hole, and beyond the white stakes right side of Hole 18 tee box.

2. **INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE**
All boundary fences, bridges, concrete drains, culverts and wooden retaining structures around the ponds are integral parts of the course.

3. **IMMOVABLE CONSTRUCTIONS**
All sheds, fixed sprinkler heads, control boxes, sumps, hazard stakes (yellow and red), distance markers, index markers, sign-posts, buggy track, service road, lamp posts on the 9th and 18th holes, are immovable obstructions, and relief may be obtained under Rule 24-2. The ball may be cleaned when lifted.

4. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR (GUR)**
Any area so marked with white paint. The player may take relief under Rule 25-1.

5. **YOUNG TREES (identified by black stakes)**
If such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of his intended swing, the ball **MUST** be lifted without penalty and dropped in accordance under Rule 24-2b (i) – immovable obstruction. The ball may be cleaned when lifted.

6. **WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26-1)**
 - a) Water Hazard are defined by yellow stakes and/or lines
 - b) Lateral Water Hazard are defined by red stakes and/or lines.
(Note: where both stakes and lines are used, the lines define the margin of the hazard).
 - c) Dropping Zones.
Dropping Zones where designated are optional.
They are on Hole 2, 5, 13, 14, 15, 17 and 18.

7. **STONES IN BUNKERS.**
Stones in bunkers are movable obstruction. Rule 24-1 applies.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES-

Match Play-Loss of Hole. Stroke Play-Two Strokes.
