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EDITOR'S MESSAGE



Time flies. Since the MCO (Movement control order) was implemented for Malaysia on 18th March, 2020, the General Committee complied fully with the lockdown SOP – the front gates were closed and no vehicular movement was allowed. All activities ceased completely.

Most members had been waiting anxiously on the announcement of Director General of Health on the Covid 19, and were overjoyed to hear the partial opening up of SGCC for golfing activities with social distancing, sanitizing procedure and the one buggy one golfer - RM60 per golfer for 18 holes! Gradually, other facilities followed suit. The Rainforest Square for Martial Arts – for Tai Chi members subject to maximum 20 persons with proper social distancing have been cherished by members. Swimming pool, gym, yoga, tennis, Table tennis and others also available for non-golfing members.

We are glad that the fairways have been improved and the previous land slipped edge of pond green no 9 is patched up, and while the side of fairway no 15 also well repaired. Our captain and his committee must be given the credits for the improvement of the fairways – the overgrown branches of the trees have been prudently pruned, leaving the greens to have adequate sunlight for grass to grow evenly on the greens.

With the extended MCO, there was not enough time for the current committee to accomplish the original goals, and the AGM, due in May 2020 has now postponed till 15th August, 2020. Members must exert their discretion in returning GC members who have proven their willingness to serve the club for another term – bearing in mind of the long lockdown period of SGCC.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



It has been a year (and a bit) since this Committee took office and what a year it has been. I would like to thank all my fellow committee members for a thoroughly enjoyable time in office. We have had our differences, but we have never failed to come to an agreement. I would like to think that we have worked and gelled together as a team. It has been a pleasure to have served the club together with you.

We set out at the start of our term with the following main goals: To increase income for the club, to improve the clubhouse through refurbishment and enhancements for member's enjoyment, to improve the golf course and its' operations and to present a long term vision of the club.

Much good work has been done by the previous committee under President Mr Shiak Vui Ming and his team in reducing cost, especially in staffing levels. We focused on increasing recurring income on the back of this good work.

Our golf club benefits from having frontage along the busy Jalan Lintas and the high waiting traffic at the main entrance. Opportunities to monetise these advantages have never been taken despite many proposals. We are pleased to have committed to a multi-year deal with Boco Media Sdn Bhd for a LED billboard to be placed at the side of the main entrance of the clubhouse. This will bring recurring income for the club going forward and further collaborations may be possible if they are mutually beneficial to our billboard operator and the club.

The clubhouse has been completely repainted, with remedial water proofing works done on the roofs and it now looks sparkling. Various improvements have been undertaken to modernise the changing rooms. The swimming pool has been totally retiled and repaired and will serve us well for some time to come. Various improvements to the club has also been secured via sponsorship by our very generous members including score cards, changing room towels and flooring, machineries for the golf course and sponsorships of golf tournaments. These are amongst the more notable improvements made.

The highlight of the year was the co-hosting of the World Golf Amateur Championship 2019, the most prestigious amateur golf tournament in the world. More than 400 amateur golfers from over 40 countries descended on Kota Kinabalu to compete for the title of World Amateur Champions. Malaysia easily won the team event to bring home the title and we now have a World Champion amongst the ranks of SGCC members! Big kudos to the Captain and his committee for their hard work to ensure that the event proceeded as planned. Further improvements to our golf course will be covered in detail by the Captain's Report.

The Sabah government's decision to stop the issuance of trading licenses to gaming facilities meant that our slot machine room operations ceased on the 1st of January 2020. This will affect our clubs' income as the machine room has averaged more than RM500,000 per annum in income for the past 5 years ending 2019. Difficult decisions will have to be made regarding how we can make up for this shortfall.

A proposal to increase the subscriptions was made in November of last year which was rescinded due to a technicality. It was then proposed amongst the GC that this increase will be brought up at a later date. The onset

of the pandemic brought these plans to a stop. With so much uncertainty and shaky economic outlook, it would be prudent to shelf any plans for subscription increase until a later, more suitable time.

I still maintain that in order for SGCC to be a vibrant, progressive and thriving club, subscriptions must be increased so that substantial investments in the club house, all of the country facilities and the golf course can be made. For too long our membership value has stagnated and we would like to present a vision of SGCC as a RM100,000 club and we believe improvements to the clubhouse and the facilities first and foremost will bring us closer to this target. It is clear heavy investments are needed to realize these visions. We have had a draft made (at no cost to the club) on a possible vision of the clubhouse which is presented within this publication.

The COVID-19 pandemic has brought much disruption globally. We have not been spared in terms of facility accessibility to members, staffing and the 'new normal' way of operating whilst the virus lives amongst us. All club operations ceased on the 18th March as per MCO requirements except for a few staff. Financially, the club have lost income from lower F&B spending/income, loss of rental and reduced golfing income. We obtained Bantuan Prihatin Nasional for our staff and that has offset some of the losses but the pandemic will negatively affect the financial accounts for the year.

The club was finally re-opened on the 14th May after nearly two months of closure. We have been operating within government guidelines and prescribed standard operating procedures. We look forward to the day when restrictions are lifted and we can return to building a stronger SGCC for the future.

Lastly on behalf of the General Committee of 2019/2020, I wish all members and their families good health, to remain safe and we thank you all for your support. To the next General Committee, we wish you all the best as you bring our club towards more success in future. It has been an honor to be part of the General Committee of Sabah Golf and Country Club.

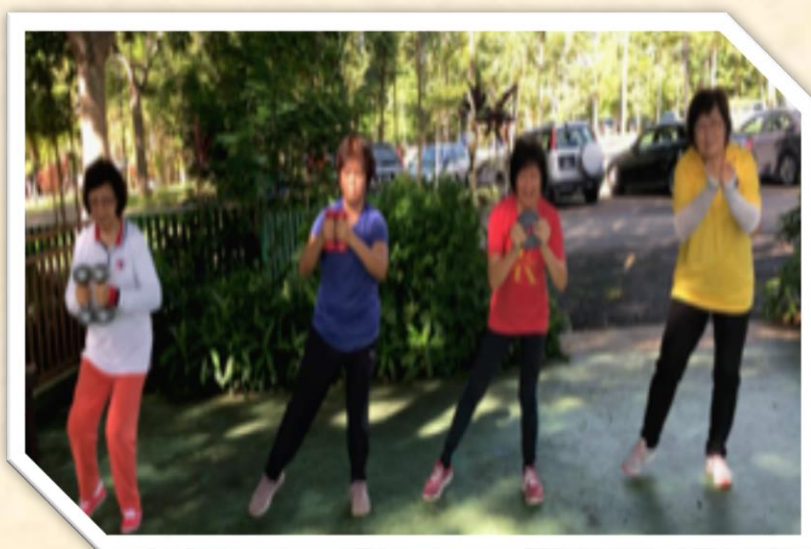
